

THE PEOPLE OF GOD'S KINGDOM

In our Gospel reading from Matthew, we hear the Beatitudes, the stirring opening to the Sermon on the Mount. Jesus is proclaiming the coming of the kingdom of God, and begins by considering what kind of people will enter and participate in this kingdom. They are the poor in spirit, the meek, the clean of heart, the peacemakers. We hear both Zephaniah and Paul echo this, as God specifically chooses the weak and the lowly to be God's agents in ushering in the reign of God. By living with humility and integrity, their hearts are open to being transformed by the grace of God. We too are called to live in this way. Jesus invites us to be people with open hearts, to receive God's blessing. And working through us, God may bless all of creation.

In Christ,

The season of Lent is less than a month away. Our Lord pours out an abundance of grace for those who take advantage of this important season of penance and preparation. One of the great ways to dispose ourselves to grace is to commit to special times for prayer and devotion. One devotion that is particularly appropriate during Lent is the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.



This devotion stems from a series of private revelations made by the risen Christ to a young Polish religious sister. For over seven years, from 1931 to 1938, Jesus appeared to Faustina Kowalska, now revered as St. Faustina. Each time he appeared to her, the Lord showed Faustina the rays of his infinite Mercy, which flowed from the wounds in his heart. He explained to her that: *“The rays represent the Blood and Water which gushed forth from the depths of my Mercy when my agonizing Heart was pierced on the cross. The pale rays symbolize the water; which purifies and cleanses the soul; the red rays represent the blood, which gives new life to the soul. These rays will shield the soul before the justice of My Father. Fortunate are those who live in this shelter, for the justice of God will not reach them there...The greater the sinner, the greater the Mercy. I desire to save all, for the well of my Mercy was opened wide with a lance on the cross, for all souls. No one do I exclude...Let the very sinful fear not to approach Me, for even if their sins be as numerous as all the sands of the earth, all will be forgiven in the fathomless pit of my Mercy.”*

There is a painting of Jesus as he appeared to St. Faustina in the parish church. Jesus instructed her: *“Paint an image according to the pattern you see with the signature: Jesus, I Trust in You. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish. I am offering people a vessel with which they are to keep coming for graces to the fountain of mercy. That vessel is this image with the signature. I desire that this image be venerated, first in your chapel, and then throughout the world.”*

It was to St. Faustina that Jesus gave not only this image for prayer, but the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. It may be said any time, but Jesus specifically told St. Faustina to recite it during the nine days before the Feast of Mercy (The first Sunday after Easter). He said: *“I desire that during these nine days you bring souls to the fountain of My mercy, that they may draw therefrom strength and refreshment and whatever grace they need in the hardships of life, and especially, at the hour of death.”*

For the nine weeks preceding the Feast of Divine Mercy, April 16th, we will venerate the holy image of Divine Mercy, pray the chaplet given to St. Faustina, and offer to Jesus in the novena our own souls and those of the whole world. Starting on Thursday, February 16th, we will gather for the novena every Thursday evening, except during Holy Week when it will move to Wednesday. On each of those evenings we will have the sacrament of reconciliation at 5PM, Mass at 6PM (with a homily focused on Divine Mercy), conclude Mass with exposition of the Most Blessed Sacrament, the novena prayers, singing of the Divine Mercy chaplet, and conclude at 7PM with Eucharistic benediction.

Please commit to these nine special evenings of prayer given to the Church by Jesus himself! Mark your calendars *right now*. February 16 and 23; March 2, 9, 16, 23, and 30; April 5 and 13. Invite everyone you know to join us. Bring with you all your concerns and worries. Come entrust yourself and your loved ones to the Lord's Divine Mercy.


