Attention: MBS Graduating 8th Graders,

Each year, Most Blessed Sacrament Home and School Association and Most Blessed Sacrament Catholic School offer a scholarship award opportunity for our graduating 8th Grade students. The Spirit of MBS Award is a monetary award honoring the memory of MBS students who gained their angel wings while attending MBS or prior to completing college. These MBS angels left a lasting impression on the hearts of those they left behind, and their legacy lives among us each day.

This award is made possible through the generosity and partnership of the MBS Home and School Association, families of past and present MBS students, and MBS Faculty and Staff. Donations from the Jill Peno Pajama Day collection are divided equally. Half of the proceeds support the Jill Peno Memorial Scholarship Fund, and the other half supports the Spirit of MBS Scholarship Fund. The minimum amount awarded each year will be \$1000 towards the cost of tuition to St. Michael High School, Catholic High School or St. Joseph Academy.

The recipient of this award must:

- be a current 8th grader in good academic standing (must have all A's, B's, and C's)
- attend a Catholic High School in Baton Rouge upon graduation
- live in a household that is registered as a member of MBS Church Parish and demonstrates active participation in both the MBS School and MBS Church communities
- live the mission of MBS by serving the Church, its families, and the community and by nurturing Gospel values, academic excellence, and a lifetime of prayer and service
- demonstrate the fruits of the spirit: joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control
- possess strong writing and communication skills via the essay answers
