 Partnerships and Director of Postsecondary Content, you will utilize established materials
 to implement transition support in identified districts in North Louisiana. Through
 implementation, you solicit input from internal and external partners to understand what
 is and is not working about our approach and propose adjustments in alignment with
 what you are learning.
- Support Inclusive Workplaces. You know that in order for students and people with disabilities to be successful in early careers, workplaces need to transform into inclusive environments. Alongside the Direction of Partnerships and Director of Postsecondary Content, you will utilize established materials to implement inclusive workplace support in partner districts. Through implementation, you solicit input from internal and external partners to understand what is and is not working about our approach and propose adjustments in alignment with what you are learning.
- Foster Community with Key Partners. You recognize the value of relationships and their influence on the success of an overall initiative. You know how to strike the right balance between someone our partners trust and someone who pushes them to their full potential. With this in mind, you develop deep, trusting relationships with internal and external partners and leverage these to navigate complex aspects of our long-term goals. This includes being present in the communities we serve, attending events such as Board meetings and school functions while at the same time engaging in walkthroughs and observations of local buildings and classrooms.

This is a full-time position located from a home office in North Louisiana with travel expected. The salary range for this position is \$75,000 - \$85,000.
