

ORDER

On motion of, and at the request of Clerks of Court Jason Harris (Livingston), Jeremy Williams (St. Helena) and Gary Stanga (Tangipahoa) upon representation to the Court, that to remain in conjunction with the offices of the Twenty-first Judicial District Court, it is recommended that the offices of the Livingston, St. Helena, and Tangipahoa Clerks of Court be closed Monday, October 14, 2024 due to the Columbus Day Holiday. The Livingston, St. Helena and Tangipahoa Parishes Clerks of Court will reopen on Tuesday, October 15, 2024 for regular business hours.

IT IS ORDERED, that, pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 1:55E(2), that the Offices of the Clerks of Court for the Parishes of Livingston, St. Helena and Tangipahoa be closed Monday, October 14, 2024 due to the Columbus Day Holiday, and that Livingston, St. Helena and Tangipahoa Clerks of Court will reopen on Tuesday, October 15, 2024 for regular business hours. Further, pursuant to the provisions of this section, the Clerks shall attach a statement advising of the action to every petition or pleading filed in the Office of the Clerk of Court on the first day or part of a date his office shall be reopened when such petition or document relates to a cause of action, right of appeal, or other matter against which prescription could have run or time periods imposed by law could have expired.
