THEREFORE, Chief Judge F. Hugh Larose of the 17th Judicial District Court in and for

the Parish of Lafourche, does hereby declare that all offices of the 17th Judicial District Court and

the Clerk of Court for this District and Parish shall close on Tuesday, January 21, 2025 and

Wednesday, January 22, 2025 and if necessary shall remain closed until such time weather permits

the safe opening of Clerk and Court facilities for the reasons stated above, and with the authority

stated in La. R.S. 1, Section 55 (E)(1)(b) and La. R.S. 1, Section 55(E)(2).

Considering the reasons stated, the foregoing Emergency Closure Order is confirmed and

ordered, in accordance with law.
