EMERGENCY COURT CLOSURE ORDER
PURSUANT TO LA. R.S. 1:55(E)(2)

Upon motion of the Clerk of Court, and with approval of the Chief Judge of the 11th Judicial District Court, considering the emergency situation caused by current weather conditions rendering it hazardous or otherwise unsafe for the Clerk's employees to continue in the performance of their official duties or for the general public to conduct business with the Clerk's office:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, pursuant to La. R.S. 1:55(E)(2), the offices of the Sabine Parish Clerk of Court and the 11th Judicial District Court shall be closed on Tuesday, January 21, 2025.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to La. R.S. 1:55(E)(3), January 21, 2025, shall be a legal holiday.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all cases set for hearing on January 21, 2025, other than those previously continued by Order or agreement of counsel, shall be upset and refixed on February 4, 2025, at 9:00 a.m. Regarding each affected case, the Clerk shall cause notice of refixing to be served upon all counsel of record and any unrepresented party.

La. R.S. 1:55(E)(2)

If an emergency situation develops which, in the judgment of the clerk of court, renders it hazardous or otherwise unsafe for employees of the office of the clerk to continue in the performance of their official duties or for the general public to conduct business with the clerk's office, the clerk, with prior approval from the clerk's chief judge, may order the closing of the office for the duration of the hazardous or unsafe condition.
