

CLOSURE ORDER FOR THE 6TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT COURT FOR THE PARISHES OF EAST CARROLL, MADISON AND TENSAS

Acting pursuant to Article V, Section I, of the Louisiana Constitution of 1974, as amended, and the inherent power of this Court:

IT IS ORDERED that:

The 6th Judicial District Court, including the Clerks of Court, for the Parishes of East Carroll, Madison, and Tensas, in recognition of the State Declared Holiday of Juneteenth, shall be closed on Friday, June 20, 2025, and will reopen for business on Monday, June 23, 2025.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to R.S. 1:55.1 the third Saturday in June, Juneteenth Day, has been declared a day of public rest and a legal holiday, and pursuant to R.S. 1:55(B) (4) when a holiday falls on a full-time employee's regular day off (Saturday), the holiday shall be the closest regularly scheduled work day preceding or following the legal holiday, therefore the Court shall be closed on Friday, June 20, 2025, and this day is declared a legal holiday.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to the declaration signed on May 2, 2025, by Governor Jeff Landry, declaring that the State of Louisiana shall observe Juneteenth Day in conjunction with the federal holiday as a legal holiday on June 19, 2025, the court recognizes June 19, 2025, as a filing holiday and all filings due on June 19, 2025, shall be deemed timely filed if filed on or before Monday, June 23, 2025. Further, employees in the Clerks of Courts' offices and the Judiciary are required to work on June 19, 2025, to maintain an efficient operation. Further the employees in the Clerks of Courts' offices and the Judiciary shall celebrate the legal holiday on Friday, June 20, 2025.
